Competent (60%)	Citation formatting style is chosen but incorrect in more than a few instances	The requirement amount of sources are present but they do not provide clear evidence of research into a specific area and/or it is unclear how they relate to one another. Proficient (80%)	Citation formatting style is chosen and clear but has a few mistakes	The source requirement is met and there are only a few annotations that do not make clear why the sources are relevant	Grammar is readable and has a few errors that were not changed during revision
